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Brentwood Sportsplex Rental Information Restriction Exemption Program (REP) Protocols

Make sure you email this document to all the participants in your group so that they are aware of the protocols in place at Brentwood Sportsplex prior to their arrival.

All patrons that enter the Brentwood Sportsplex have the understanding of the increased risks of entering public spaces due to the Covid19 Pandemic and you are therefore releasing the Brentwood Community Association, Board of Directors and its Employees from any liability due to the Covid 19 Pandemic.

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES BY EVERYONE ENTERING THE BUILDING EXCEPT FOR WHEN PARTICIPATING ON THE ICE.

ANYONE 12 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER MUST HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING AND BE ABLE TO PRODUCE IF REQUESTED TO ENTER THE BRENTWOOD SPORTSPLEX:

1. Proof of vaccination and picture ID.
 - a. A single dose accepted between September 20 and October 25 if received 2 weeks prior to coming to Brentwood Sportsplex.
 - b. Double dose required after October 25, 2021
2. Original documentation of a medical exemption (not a copy)
3. Proof of a privately paid negative COVID-19 rapid test within 72 hours of coming to the Brentwood Sportsplex.

Every rental group must provide a representative present at every booking and must be here at least 40 minutes prior to your ice time.

If you have a visiting team joining your ice time it is your responsibility to make sure they know all the rules and supply a representative for their teams check in. please forward the information to them or they can find it on the BCA website.

Front doors will be locked so your representative must call the Arena Attendant (403) 200-7914 when they arrive and report to them as the representative for your group.

The duties of the representative are as follows:

- Check that everyone in their group 12 years of age and older is compliant with the current vaccine protocols as set by the Restriction Exemption Program and City of Calgary Vaccine Passport Bylaw.
- Ensure no one from their group enters the facility more than 30 minutes ahead of their ice time.
- Ensure all who enter are wearing masks.
- Ensure that everyone in their group practices social distancing.
- Spectators may enter once the ice time starts and that only 1 spectator per participant enters the facility.

It is very important that all REP protocols are followed. AHS will be doing audits of recreational facilities to confirm compliance. If they find violations there is a risk of fines and forced closure of the Brentwood Sportsplex.

Brentwood Sportsplex Staff will be doing spot audits as well. Please be willing and understanding when asked and produce documentation when requested.

Persons not following AHS, City of Calgary and Brentwood Sportsplex protocols will be asked to leave immediately, so please respect everyone's safety while using our facility.

We are all trying to do the best to keep our facility open and your full cooperation is needed.

SPECTATORS:

- One spectator per participant and they must avoid being in the same area as the participants. They must social distance at all times.
- Do not enter the facility until your ice time starts and leave as soon as ice time is over and wait outside to avoid crowding in the facility.
- Bleachers may be used with social distancing and standing room around the arena boards are marked with yellow tape for distancing.

PARTICIPANTS

- All participants should show up dressed and ready to play when possible.
- You must enter the building no more than 30 minutes before your ice time and leave as quickly as possible. (Maximum 40 Minutes)

- Make sure you bring your own water bottles already full. Water bottles left behind will be thrown out, so make sure you take all your stuff with you when you leave.
- Masking everywhere in the building except for ice surface.

DRESSING ROOMS

Dressing room assignments will be posted on the white board in the lobby.

Each ice time will be assigned 2 rooms. If you are using room 4 you will be given access to Dressing Room 5 provided it is not being used as a Gender Dressing Room.

- Masks are to be worn at all times
- You must stay seated in your assigned dressing room until the ice is ready for you, at that time remove your mask, put your helmet on and go straight onto the ice. (do not gather in the rink area when ice is being resurfaced)
- Rooms will be used to full capacity provided MASKING RULE is followed at all times.
- Solo ice times may request two rooms to allow for social distancing.
- Showers are available but you still must be out of the building promptly after your ice time is over.

Rapid Response Plan

It is the responsibility of your group representative to implement this plan.

If a participant or Coach begins to show signs of described Covid 19 symptoms while in the facility:

- Immediately isolate the symptomatic participant from others and arrange for quick egress from the facility and safe travel home.
- Notify Facility Operator and he will sanitize all areas where symptomatic participant may have been.
- Suspend the activity in progress and have all participants leave the facility as quickly as possible.
- If another rental group is in the facility at the same time they must also be informed of the incident.

An uninterrupted season is at stake so your cooperation is key for us to be able to stay open. During this uncertain time it is very important that we all respect everyone's well-being, treat each other with respect and follow all the protocols set out by AHS.
