Re: July Construction Activities

We thank you for your continued cooperation with the construction activities occurring on the corner of Brisbois and Northmount Drive. As part of keeping the communication lines open, we are presenting a general overview of the July construction activities for your information.

In July, the major construction activities to commence/continue are as follows:

- Exterior cladding systems & glazing
- Roof top equipment installation – Will require lane closures on Northmount for crane hoisting
- Asphalt lane way – Tentative for end of July pending City of Calgary review
- Interior Finishes to base building
- Parkade finishes
- Misc concrete pours – toppings & stairs
- Perimeter building grading

These construction activities will have the following effects:

- o Occasional building material deliveries could require lane or sidewalk closures on Northmount and or Brisbois. These will be applied for and executed with assistance from The City of Calgary
- o Lane way paving will require a minimum 1 week closure from Brisbois to Brockington – Notice of when this is going to be occurring to be issued once scheduled

As general practice, Bird does not typically work Sundays or Statuary Holidays; however, there will be exceptions made if it becomes a necessity to meet scheduling demands. All construction activities will adhere to the bylaws and regulations set out by the City of Calgary.
