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Brentwood Sportsplex Rental Information

Make sure you email this document to all the participants so that they are aware of the protocols in place prior to their arrival.

By confirming your rental at the Brentwood Sportsplex and entering our facility, you are releasing the Brentwood Community Association, Board of Directors and its Employees from any liability due to the Covid19 Pandemic.

All patrons that enter the Brentwood Sportsplex have the understanding of the increased risks of entering public spaces due to the Covid19 Pandemic and you enter at your own risk.

Protocols are in place to make our facility safer, however, it is also the responsibility of all who enter to follow all protocols to avoid the transmission of the Covid19 virus and keep this facility as safe as possible.

Facility Rules

- 15 minute break between rentals unless otherwise agreed upon.
- You must provide a representative at every booking to coordinate screening of all participants and man the front door for late arrivals.
- A contact tracing list of all participants must be kept.
- Social distancing of 3 meters must be maintained at all times.
- **NO SPECTATORS**
- Dressing rooms are not available, all participants must come dressed and ready to play.
- Water fountain and vending machines not in service.
- Bring your own water bottle already full. **DO NOT SHARE BOTTLES**
- Public washrooms limited to one person at a time.
- Doors will be open 5 minutes prior to your start time. Be sure to practice Social Distancing while waiting outside.

- All participants must enter and exit the facility through front doors only! West lobby doors entrance/ East lobby doors exit. All other exits to be used for emergencies only.
- Enter arena area through main lobby doors only, labeled Entrance and Exit.
- Enter arena floor through the gate at the end of the arena surface that you group will be using. Ends are denoted by HOME and VISITORS
- **BLEACHERS ARE CLOSED**
Bottom row of bleachers only available to change shoes if required. Do not use the chairs. Yellow "X" placed on the bottom row to mark 3 meter distancing.
- All participants must practice 3 meter Social Distancing at all times.
- When your rental is over must exit the facility as quickly as possible.
- We strongly recommend that you not congregate in the parking lot. When doing drop off and pick up please leave parking lot as soon as possible.
- We suggest that for pick up you park in the parking lot to the east of facility and wait in your car. By using the east parking lot for pickup it will free up parking spots in front of the building for the next group to use for drop off.
- At the completion of your rental time you must vacate the parking lot in a timely manner.

During this uncertain time it is very important that we all respect everyone's wellbeing and follow all the Protocols set out by AHS.

Protocols may change at any time as a result of AHS rule changes.

AHS GUIDELINES

Mandatory restrictions - Province wide - Effective Feb. 8

All participants must be 18 years old or younger, except coaches or trainers.

Youth group physical activities

Children and youth will be allowed to participate in limited group activities.

- Lessons, practices and physical conditioning activities are allowed for indoor and outdoor minor sports/activities and school athletics (for example, school sport activities that are outside of a physical education class or related part of the school curriculum).
- Games are not allowed.
- Maximum of 10 total individuals, including all coaches, trainers, and participants.
- A playing surface (for example, arena, field, court or swimming pool) may be occupied by more than one youth group, as long as 3-metres of physical distancing can be maintained between groups of 10 and the groups do not intermingle.
- Physical distancing must be maintained between participants at all times:
 - 3-metres physical distance for indoor activities
 - coaches or trainers may enter physical distancing space for brief interactions with participants (for example, to correct form or technique)
 - Participants must be masked at all times, except during the training activity. Coaches and trainers must remain masked at all times.
- Access to change rooms must be limited, including accelerated arrival and departure, emergencies (for example, first aid) and washroom use.
